

### 6.5 Km Route Orange Route

1. Through kissing gate left corner recreation ground, over style directly ahead, keep hedge on left hand side to gate. Head on a 10 o'clock bearing over style in the hedge, same bearing to another style, turn right on bridle path (Green Lane). Follow bridle path to the end, turn right tarmac lane to crossroads straight over crossroads. Beware of traffic. Follow Limekiln lane over railway bridge. The lane is long and straight, and leads to a T junction with Tanhouse lane. At this junction turn right and go over another railway bridge.
3. At the next cross roads, turn right into Oldwood Lane which is not marked or signposted, it is a stone track with metal post to stop traffic near the start. At the end of the lane turn left up the hill on the road towards Rangeworthy. The second road on the right is a small estate called The Grove, turn into this estate and walk straight ahead the road changes to a tarmac footpath between houses with a style at the end.
4. Crossing over this style head for the far right corner of the field and then into the next field (some of the hedges in the fields are incomplete, however the hedge outline can still be seen). In the next field head to the far left corner where there is a style next to what used to be a gate, cross this style. In the next field turn right and walk beside the hedge keeping it on your right side, a style and small foot bridge lies ahead which leads into the recreation ground where you started, the changing rooms and Rose and Crown are now on the left at the far end of the grounds.
